Updates from the Executive Director

Mr. VonCannon provided the following updates to the Board:

• Following a lengthy search, WSACC has filled the position of Assistant Engineering Director. Mr. Kevin Loescher is coming to WSACC with extensive experience in utility projects and is anticipated to begin filling the duties of the Assistant Engineering Director in January 2025 following his relocation from the Maryland area.

 WSACC held their Employee Awards Banquet and Christmas Luncheon on December 5, 2024. WSACC recognized eight employees with ten (10) years or more of service. WSACC currently has fifty-seven (57) active employees, with twenty-five (25) of those employees having ten years or more of service. Currently, WSACC's most tenured employee is Wayne Dabbs, with 57 years of service.

Request for Approval of the Back Creek Interceptor Construction Phase Services.

Mr. Hahn requested approval of the Scope and Fee for the Back Creek Interceptor Construction Phase Services not to exceed \$283,040.00.

Mr. Marshall made a motion to approve the Scope and Fee for the Back Creek Interceptor Construction Phase Services. Mr. Shue seconded the motion, and the Board approved by unanimous vote.

<u>Request for Approval of the Resolution Authorizing Official Disposal of Property at Public</u> <u>Auction</u>

Mr. Hahn informed the Board that during recent electrical upgrades at the Rocky River Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant ("RRRWWTP"), an existing two-megawatt ("2-MW") generator was replaced by two three-megawatt generators, therefor WSACC would like to sell the 2-MW generator at public auction on GovDeals.com and place notice of the sale on WSACC's website. Preliminary pricing values the 2-MW generator at approximately \$100,000.

Mr. Hahn requested approval of the Resolution Authorizing Official Disposal of Property at Public Auction as required by North Carolina General Statute § 160A-266 and §160A-270 for surplus property valued more than \$30,000.

Ms. Parsley-Hubbard made a motion to approve the Resolution Authorizing Official Disposal of Property at Public Auction. Mr. Holloway seconded the motion, and the Board approved by unanimous vote.

The resolution was approved as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OFFICIAL DISPOSAL OF PROPERTY AT PUBLIC AUCTION

WHEREAS, the Water and Sewer Authority of Cabarrus County, a body politic and corporate organized and existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina, is the owner of certain property deemed surplus to its needs and no longer necessary for the conduct of public business; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S.) § 160A-266 and § 160A-270, a local government may dispose of personal or real property by public auction, including electronic auction, upon authorization by the governing board; and

WHEREAS, the governing board of the Water and Sewer Authority of Cabarrus County has determined that it is in the public interest to dispose of the said property at an electronic public auction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing board of the Water and Sewer Authority of Cabarrus County as follows:

 Authorization of Disposal: The governing board hereby declares the following property surplus to the needs of the Water and Sewer Authority of Cabarrus County and authorizes its disposal by public auction:

Generator Set disposition includes:

- Automatic transfer switch control system

- Terms of Sale: The property shall be sold "as is" to the highest bidder. The terms of the sale shall require payment in full by the successful bidder at the time of the auction, unless otherwise specified in the auction terms.
- Publication of Notice: The Clerk is directed to publish a electronic notice of public auction in accordance with the requirements of N.C.G.S. § 160A-270.
- 5. Effective Date: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
